MATLAB Themes

This tutorial shows you how to change color schemes for MATLAB and Slack

- 1. Go to: https://www.mathworks.com/matlabcentral/fileexchange/53862-matlab-schemer
 - a. This should take you to the MathWork File Exchange
- 2. Download MATLAB Schemer
 - a. You will need to sign into you MathWorks Account in order to do so.
- 3. Extract the file
 - a. Find the file wherever your downloads are stored
- 4. Open schemer import.m in MATLAB
- 5. Run the Code with no inputs
 - a. Remember the file location must be in your active directory
 - b. Either go to the EDITOR tab and click Run or enter schemer_import in the command window
 - c. This will open a Select File to Open window
- 6. Select the schemes folder
- 7. Select any one of the .prf file (I prefer dark steel usually, but if its Friday and I want to swallow the blue pill, I go Matrix)

Other features of the code:

- You can export a scheme you make using schemer_export.m
- There are screen shots of all the schemes under schemes => screenshots

Try out all the schemes and pick your favorite!

- 1. From the desktop version of Slack, click the workspace name (where is says CURENT ERC in the upper left)
- 2. Select Preferences
